- Discussion on the logo:
 - The Logo discussed at ICC'16 is too GUI-like and haptic oriented. It will be replaced by a new logo.
 - VP will ask professionals to design a logo for the TI TSC
 - The following logos were presented based on the received feedback during the ICC'16 meeting





- In general, the logos received positive feedback, but there was a discussion on using these to highlight the aspects TI captures rather than using them as a TI-logo. They are too complex for a logo. It has been decided to use one of the alternatives on the website's home tab directly at the top
- Discussion on the website:
 - The TI definition will be shifted to the top.
 - The demos and events should be on a separate tab
 - More activities will be added to the website, once received
 - There was a request to create a Tactile Internet article at Wikipedia, so that any misunderstanding can be avoided and more publicity is achieved
 - Add the ITU-T watch report under 'standardization'
- Updates on standardization activities was presented, mainly wrt ETSI
 - Toshiba Europe Research, Bristol UK officially joined the activities

Teaser talk on TouCHES

- Prof. Carlo Fischione from KTH Sweden gave a teaser talk on the TouCHES project: Tactile CyberpHysical nEtworkS
- The TouCHES is a Swedish funded project
- Prof. Fischione also presented a new startup on smart music http://www.mindmusiclabs.com/mind/

Updates on the Tactile Internet IEEE standardization activities (Oliver Holland)

- Dr. Oliver Holland gave an overview on IEEE standardization activities and invited the attendees to join the first kick-off meeting of the IEEE P1918.1.1 Haptic Codecs standards group
- Dr. Holland highlighted that there is a huge interest to contribute to the IEEE P1918.1 working group
- More preojects and contributions within the working group is expected in the near future. The presented slides are online available at the TIwebsite.

- The attendees were informed about the evaluation outcome of the ETC. The TI TSC will continue as a TSC and be evaluated for full TC by 2017. The outlook of the evaluation was very positive
